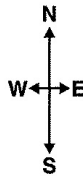
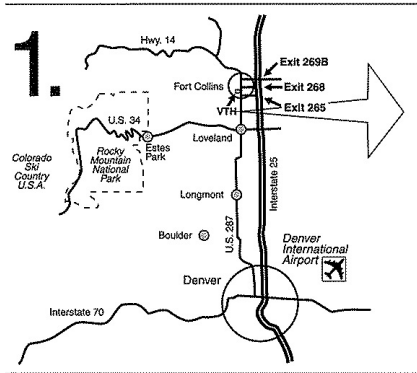


# Map/Directions to the Equine Hospital

The Equine Hospital is located on 300 West Drake Rd. in Fort Collins.

Coming from I-25 (north or south): To avoid the heaviest traffic, take the Prospect Rd. exit. Head west for 2 miles. Turn south on Timberline Rd and travel for approximately 1 mile. Turn west on Drake Rd and travel for 2.2 miles. The hospital is located 1/4 mile west of the intersection of Drake Rd. and College Ave., just past the railroad tracks on the north side of the road.

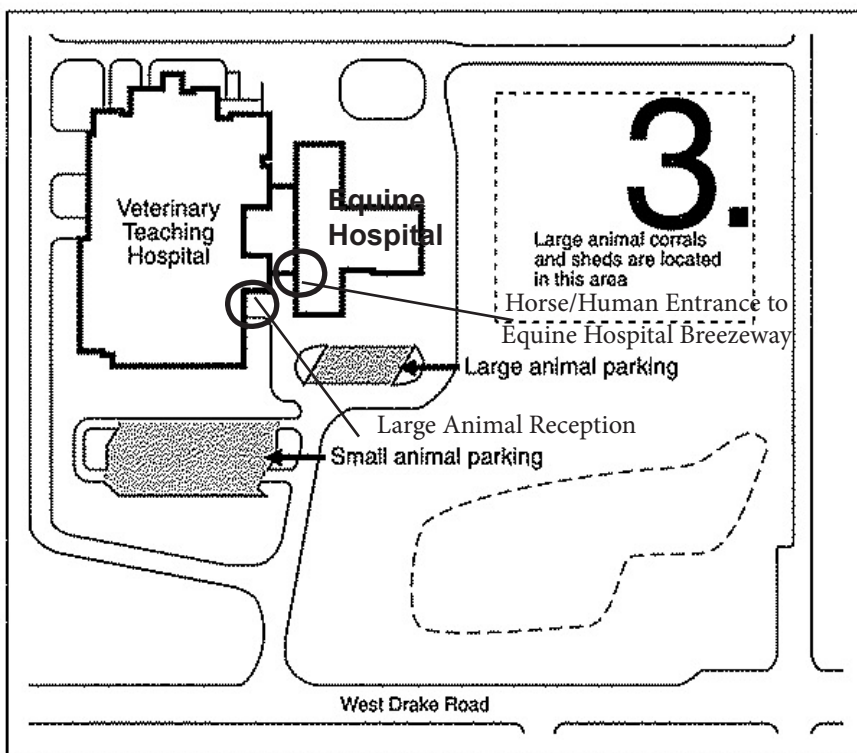

## Map of the Equine Hospital Grounds

When you arrive at the hospital, you should pull your trailer into the large parking spaces on the south east side of the facility. To check in, come in the side entrance on the east side of the teaching hospital building marked "Large Animal Reception." Once inside, one of our receptionists will greet you, ask you to sign hospital forms, and alert your veterinary medical team that you and your horse have arrived for your appointment. Once checked in, one of our fourth year veterinary students will greet you at your trailer and help you unload your horse. He/she will escort you and your horse into the hospital and ask you for information regarding your horse's history and current condition. Once inside the breezeway, your faculty clinician and the other members of your veterinary medical team will meet you and your horse for your appointment.
